Furthermore, please do not:

- Offer unauthorized advice
- Post any content, which may violate any law, may be against the public policy, or may infringe privacy rights of any person.
- Post any personal information of any kind, or requests for personal information
- Post falsifying identity
- Violate copyrighted or trademarked images, music, video, or published works without source credit or permission of the owner, including content published by the Naples Library
- Post defamatory statements about any individual, community, company or organization or any other entity
